

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING

June 18, 2024

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of June 18, 2024 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00am at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, Roads Superintendent Austin Cline, Fire Chief Shawn Davidson, and Assistant Fire Chief Colt Cline.
