

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING

September 17, 2024

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of September 17, 2024 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, Roads Superintendent Austin Cline, and Assistant Fire Chief Colt Cline. Absent was Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Visitors present were Gabe Carpenter with PCSO, Village of Ashville Mayor Steve Welsh, and firefighter Jordan Hempker.

HEARING OF VISITORS:

1. Gabe Carpenter was present to check in.
2. Mayor Steve Welsh shared that there have been requests to have a speed limit sign placed on Lockbourne Eastern Road, before Teays Valley East Middle School. He also shared that he has a meeting with Ryan Scribner regarding the 6119 district.
3. Firefighter Jordan Hempker was present to observe.

CEMETERY SEXTON/SUPERVISOR:

1. Austin shared that Gerald Webster would like to donate \$5,000 to the cemetery for new trees.

OTHER BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION 24-65

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR. Mr. Welsh moved, Mr. Mayse seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R24-65.

RESOLUTION 24-66

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 24-55 TO APPROVE UP TO \$20,000 TO BE SPENT ON A SHED, LOCATED AT THE CEMETERY. THE SHED WILL BE FUNDED FROM 60% ROADS, 30% CEMETERY, AND 10% ZONING. Mr. Welsh moved, Mr. Mayse seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R24-66.

RESOLUTION 24-67

A RESOLUTION FOR THE FUNDS SPENT ON THE NEW SHED TO COME FROM 70% ROADS AND 30% CEMETERY. Mr. Welsh moved, Mr. Mayse seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R24-67.

RESOLUTION 24-68

A RESOLUTION TO HAVE THE PICKAWAY COUNTY ENGINEER FORMALLY REQUEST FROM ODOT TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 55 MPH TO 35 MPH ON WEST OLD DUVALL COURT, AS WELL AS EAST OLD DUVALL COURT, PER THE SPEED ZONE EVALUATION SHEET. Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R24-68.

FIRE CHIEF:

1. Assistant Chief Colt Cline shared that the new grass truck sustained some damage at its first large fire. U-802 will also need fixed due to a VCT solenoid issue and timing issue.
2. Assistant Chief Colt Clines truck has the slide in unit back in it until the drought and harvest are over, for extra coverage.

RESOLUTION 24-69

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE NATHAN KENT TO PART TIME, EVERY 6TH DAY, AT \$17.00 PER HOUR, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 18, 2024. Mr. Welsh moved, Mr. Mayse seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R24-69.
