REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of April 1, 2025 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, Operations Manager Austin Cline, Fire Chief Shawn Davidson, and Assistant Fire Chief Colt Cline. Absent was Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Visitors present were PIO Steve Sabine and firefighter Jeff Rosencrance.

CEMETERY SEXTON/SUPERVISOR:

RESOLUTION 25-45

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE RANDY HALLEY FOR PART-TIME CEMETERY HELP, AT \$17.00 PER HOUR, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R25-45.

FIRE CHIEF:

Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.
