

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING

September 16, 2025

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of September 16, 2025 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Roads and Zoning Operations Manager Austin Cline, Cemetery Operations Manager Jared Conner, Assistant Chief Colt Cline, and Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Absent was Fire Chief Shawn Davidson and Township Clerk Sara LeMaster. Visitors present were PIO Steve Sabine, Gabe Carpenter with PCSO, Brian Hill and Tim Colburn with P3, Pickaway County Commissioners Jay Wippel, Harold Henson, and Gary Scherer, and firefighter Nick Krouse.

HEARING OF VISITORS:

1. Brian Hill, Tim Colburn, and the county commissioners were present for an executive session with the Trustees.
2. Firefighter Krouse was present to discuss the addendum for injury leave to the Union Contract.
