

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING

March 3, 2026

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of March 3, 2026, to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Present were Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Bill Welsh, Trustee Chad Noggle, Roads and Zoning Operations Manager Austin Cline, Fire Chief Shawn Davidson, Assistant Chief Colt Cline, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster and Cemetery Operations Manager Jared Conner. Absent was Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Visitors present were PIO Steve Sabine, South Bloomfield Village Administrator Joe Allen, John Neymeyer, Lisa McDorman, Sean Shaw, Robert Hood, JD Serio, Jim Deal, Roger Clark, Todd Younkin, Silvana Ooten, Tim Ooten, and Jeremy Scoby.

HEARING OF VISITORS:

1. Joe Allen was present to discuss the JEDD, as well as the safety services building.
2. All other visitors were present to observe.

CEMETERY:

1. Jared notified the Trustees that he will be gone April 7-28. He inquired about starting part-time help earlier this year to help cover his duties while he is gone.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

1. Chief Davidson shared that the County Commissioners will be funding a large portion of the new CAD system the county is moving to.

OTHER BUSINESS:

1. Joe Allen, as a member of the JEDD board, would like for the township to investigate how things are done and procedures followed by the JEDD board to ensure things are done correctly. He believes this could help with potential future income for the township.
2. Joe Allen inquired whether the township remains interested in pursuing a Safety Service Station. He explained that if the Fire Department agrees to staff the station, the Village of South Bloomfield would cover the impact fees, resulting in no impact fee cost to the township or to the Village of Ashville. Joe noted that an application for a \$1.5 million grant must be submitted by March 12, therefore he would like to know if he should move forward. He also stated that he would like the fire chiefs to be involved in the planning process.

RESOLUTION 26-23
