

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING

May 5, 2026

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Donnie Mayse called the Regular Trustee Meeting of May 5, 2026, to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Present were Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Bill Welsh, Trustee Chad Noggle, Roads and Zoning Operations Manager Austin Cline, Assistant Chief Colt Cline, Fire Chief Shawn Davidson, and Township Clerk Sara LeMaster. Absent were Cemetery Operations Manager Jared Conner and Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Visitors present were PIO Steve Sabine, Jim Deal, and John Neymeyer.

CEMETERY:

RESOLUTION 26-36

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE ESTIMATE OF \$49,830 FROM ROESE BROS, TO PAVE THE CEMETERY ROADS, WITH PROJECT TO BE STARTED AFTER MEMORIAL DAY. Mr. Noggle moved, Mr. Mayse seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R26-36.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

1. Chief Davidson asked the Trustees to accept the resignation of Jordan Stepp, effective April 27, 2026. Mr. Welsh made a motion to accept the resignation of Jordan Stepp, Mr. Noggle seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.
2. Chief Davidson informed the Trustees that part-time employee, Eric Spohn, was injured in a training exercise and will be off duty for six weeks.

RESOLUTION 26-37

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE COLE WARNER TO PART TIME, EVERY 6TH DAY, AT \$19.00 PER HOUR, EFFECTIVE JUNE 5, 2026. Mr. Welsh moved, Mr. Noggle seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R26-37.

OTHER BUSINESS:

1. Trustee Noggle mentioned Earnhart Hill approaching the Township about the possibility of selling 1.3 acres of land at the Northeast corner of SR 762 and Bulen Pierce Road to install a water tower. After discussion, the Trustees decided to have Trustee Noggle contact Earnhart Hill to see if they would make an offer on the land.

RESOLUTION 26-38

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$6,500 FROM CEMETERY FUND TO MEF TO COVER HALF THE COST OF THE UTV. Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Noggle seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R26-38.

RESOLUTION 26-39

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$6,500 FROM ROADS FUND TO MEF TO COVER HALF THE COST OF THE UTV. Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Noggle seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R26-39.
