

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING
February 15, 2022

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Bill Welsh called the Regular Trustee Meeting of February 15, 2022 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending were Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Cemetery Sexton/Superintendent Jared Conner, and Township Clerk Sara LeMaster. Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse, Road Superintendent Stephen Hupp, and Fire Chief Chad Noggle were absent. Firefighters Jeff Rosencrance and Robert Wall, Pickaway County Sheriff Gabe Carpenter, and Zoning Commission members, Kelly Spriggs (Chair) and Ronde Cook-Brushart (Co-Chair) were present.
