

HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING
March 1, 2022

REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Bill Welsh called the Regular Trustee Meeting of March 1, 2022 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending were Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Jim Deal, Trustee Bill Welsh, Cemetery Sexton/Superintendent Jared Conner, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse, and Fire Chief Chad Noggle.
