

**HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING**  
**July 19, 2022**

**REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Bill Welsh called the Regular Trustee Meeting of July 19, 2022 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Bill Welsh, Operations Manager Jared Conner, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, and Fire Chief Shawn Davidson. Absent was Trustee Jim Deal and Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse. Also present were Pickaway County Auditor Melissa Betz, PIO Steve Sabine, and Firefighters Brian Kirkpatrick, Anthony Mastracci, Jeremy Lust, Brian Kirkpatrick, Peyton Strader, Perry Heiby, Bailey Butler, and Caleb Jones.

**HEARING OF VISITORS:**

1. Melissa Betz was present to certify the Estimated Property Tax Revenue for the fire levy.
2. The firefighters and Steve Sabine were present to observe.

**RESOLUTION 22-65 (Fire Levy attached)**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION WITHIN HARRISON TOWNSHIP, AND TO ENACT A REPLACEMENT TAX LEVY TO RUN FOR A CONTINUING PERIOD OF TIME THAT WILL REPLACE THREE EXISTING LEVIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR AND MAINTAINING FIRE AND EMS PROTECTION WITHIN HARRISON TOWNSHIP AT AN INCREASED RATE.** Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with two affirmative votes to approve R22-65.

**RESOLUTION 22-66 (Fire Levy attached)**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MILL LIMITATION WITHIN HARRISON TOWNSHIP, AND TO ENACT A REPLACEMENT TAX LEVY TO RUN FOR A CONTINUING PERIOD OF TIME THAT WILL REPLACE THREE EXISTING LEVIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR AND MAINTAINING FIRE AND EMS PROTECTION WITHIN HARRISON TOWNSHIP, IN THE INCREASED AMOUNT OF 4 MILL.** Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with two affirmative votes to approve R22-66.
