

**HARRISON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING**  
**August 16, 2022**

**REGULAR MEETING CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Bill Welsh called the Regular Trustee Meeting of August 16, 2022 to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:00pm at the Harrison Township Fire Department, 3625 State Route 752, Ashville, Ohio 43103. Attending was Trustee Donnie Mayse, Trustee Bill Welsh, Trustee James Deal, Road Superintendent Austin Cline, Fiscal Officer Lindsay Mayse, Township Clerk Sara LeMaster, and Fire Chief Shawn Davidson. Also present was Gabe Carpenter from the Pickaway County Sheriff's Office.

**HEARING OF VISITORS:**

1. Gabe was present to check in and make sure nothing was needed from him.

**ZONING INSPECTOR:**

**RESOLUTION 22-72**

**A RESOLUTION TO GIVE THE OPERATIONS MANAGER AND ROAD SUPERINTENDENT \$400 EACH FOR A UNIFORM ALLOWANCE.** Mr. Mayse moved, Mr. Welsh seconded, and the Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve R22-72.

**ROAD SUPERINTENDENT:**

1. Austin discussed the red dump truck not having air conditioning. For an oil change and new air conditioning it would be \$1,051 at Coughlin. Mr. Mayse moved and Mr. Deal seconded to approve having the red dump truck serviced. The Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.
2. Austin discussed the roads tractor needing repaired. The cost would be \$1,442.72. Mr. Mayse moved and Mr. Deal seconded to approve having the roads tractor repaired. The Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.

**CEMETERY SEXTON/SUPERVISOR: NONE.**

**FIRE CHIEF:**

1. Chief Davidson stated they will need to use the third medic for home football games. Mr. Welsh moved and Mr. Mayse seconded to approve using the third medic for home football games.
2. Chief Davidson shared they picked up the UTV and Captain Cline would be servicing it.
3. Chief Davidson stated they need a UTV trailer and accessories and would be using funds from the American Rescue Plan. The UTV trailer would cost \$3,699.99 from Tractor Supply. Mr. Welsh moved and Mr. Mayse seconded to approve using the ARP grant for the UTV trailer. The Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.
4. Chief Davidson shared the UTV plow, blade, and mount would cost \$809.85 from Lancaster Sport Cycles. Mr. Welsh moved and Mr. Mayse seconded to approve using the ARP grant for the UTV plow, blade, and mount from Lancaster Sport Cycles. The Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.

5. Chief Davidson stated the light bars for the UTV would cost \$532.57 from LED Outfitters. Mr. Welsh moved and Mr. Mayse seconded to approve using the ARP grant for the UTV light bars from LED Outfitters. The Trustees voted with three affirmative votes to approve the motion.
